

Temporary Works (Management) Policy

Purpose: To provide a consistent, company-wide requirement to manage risks associated with temporary works in line with recognised good practice.

Policy:

All business units of Fletcher Construction that operate in New Zealand are required to:

- Identify their Designated Individual (DI) responsible for establishing, implementing and maintaining a procedure for the control of temporary works.
- Develop and implement effective Temporary Works Management Plans (TWMP), approved by the Designated Individual, consistent with industry recognised good practice.
- Appoint a Temporary Works Co-ordinator (TWC) to each project or branch.
- Appoint Temporary Works Supervisors (TWS) to assist the TWC (where required), in accordance with the TWMP.
- Ensure all appointed persons, are competent to the complexity of the work required and have been assessed as such by the DI.
- Adequately resource projects, through a comprehensive review by the Bid Manager at tender stage, such that reasonable care and judgement towards temporary works provisions have been considered.
- Record all temporary works on a Temporary Works Register (TWR) in line with the relevant TWMP.



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
